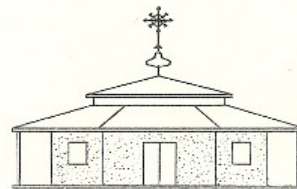

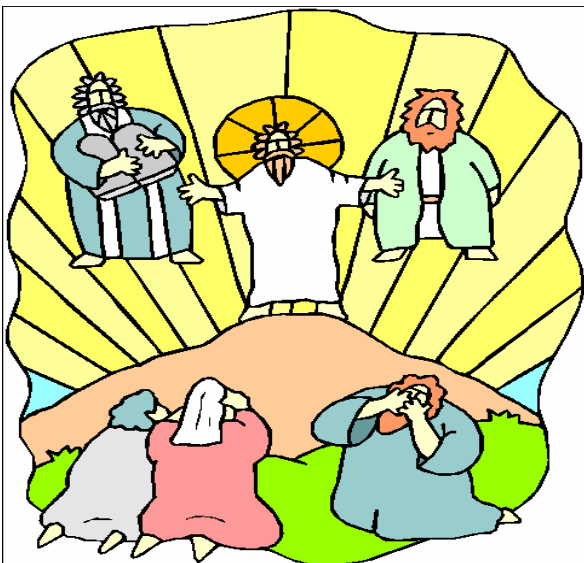

TEXT FROM VATICAN 11

It is only in freedom that people can turn themselves to what is good. The people of our time prize freedom very highly and strive eagerly for it. In this they are right. Yet they often cherish it improperly as if it gave them leave to do anything they like, even when it is evil. But genuine freedom is an exceptional sign of the image of God in humanity. For God willed that women and men should be left free to make their own decisions so that they might of their own accord seek their creator and freely attain their full and blessed perfection by cleaving to God. Since human freedom has been weakened by sin it is only by the help of God's grace that people can properly orientate their actions towards God. Human dignity rests above all on the fact that humanity is called to communion with God. The invitation to converse with God is addressed to men and women as soon as they are born. For if people exist it is because God has created them through love, and through love continues to keep them in existence. They cannot live fully in the truth unless they freely acknowledge that love and entrust themselves to their creator.
