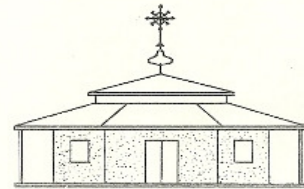

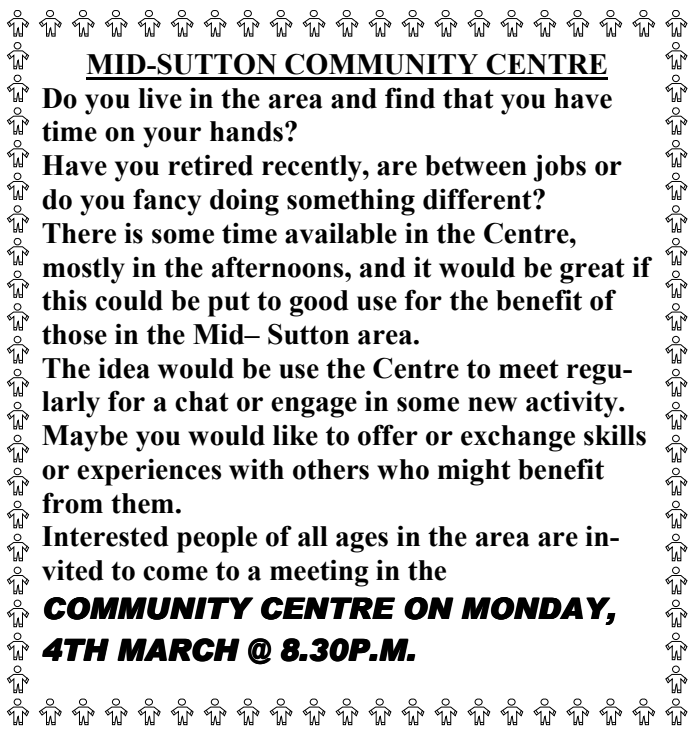


CATHOLICISM – WHAT CATHOLICS BELIEVE and WHY?

TEXT FROM VATICAN 11

For it is the function of the Church to render God the Father and his incarnate Son present and as it were visible, while ceaselessly renewing and purifying itself under the guidance of the Holy Spirit.
