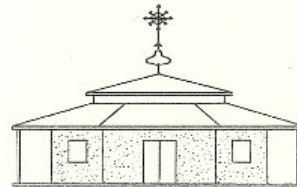

AS JESUS LEFT JERICHO WITH HIS DISCIPLES AND A LARGE CROWD, BARTIMAEUS (THAT IS, THE SON OF TIMAEUS), A BLIND BEGGAR, WAS SITTING AT THE SIDE OF THE ROAD. WHEN HE HEARD THAT IT WAS JESUS OF NAZARETH, HE BEGAN TO SHOUT AND TO SAY, 'SON OF DAVID, JESUS, HAVE PITY ON ME.' AND MANY OF THEM SCOLDED HIM AND TOLD HIM TO KEEP QUIET, BUT HE ONLY SHOUTED ALL THE LOUDER, 'SON OF DAVID, HAVE PITY ON ME.' JESUS STOPPED AND SAID, 'CALL HIM HERE.' SO THEY CALLED THE BLIND MAN. 'COURAGE,' THEY SAID, 'GET UP; HE IS CALLING YOU.' SO THROWING OFF HIS CLOAK, HE JUMPED UP AND WENT TO JESUS. THEN JESUS SPOKE, 'WHAT DO YOU WANT ME TO DO FOR YOU?' 'RABBUNI,' THE BLIND MAN SAID TO HIM, 'MASTER, LET ME SEE AGAIN.' JESUS SAID TO HIM, 'GO; YOUR FAITH HAS SAVED YOU.' AND IMMEDIATELY HIS SIGHT RETURNED AND HE FOLLOWED HIM ALONG THE ROAD.

2nd Norms for Indulgences at the Commemoration of All Souls:

1. From 12 o'clock on 1st November until midnight on 2nd November, all who have confessed, received Holy Communion and prayed for the Pope's intentions (one Our Father and Hail Mary or any other prayer of one's choice) can gain one plenary indulgence by visiting a church or oratory and their reciting one Our Father and the Apostles Creeds..

2. The faithful who visit a cemetery and pray for the dead may gain a plenary indulgence applicable only to the Holy Souls on the usual conditions once per day from 1st to 8th November. The conditions above apply for this.
