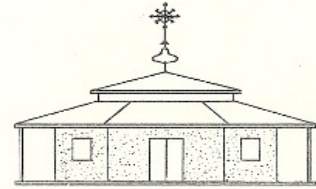

ST.MARY'S CHURCH OF IRELAND, HOWTH

2016 marks the 150th Anniversary of the opening of the present St.Marys Church in Howth, however the original Church on this site dates from 1816, which means that this year is the 200th Anniversary of a worshipping community on this site. The present Church which was opened in 1866, incorporates the tower of the original 1816 building. The move of the Church of Ireland Community to the present site in 1816 was as a result of the poor state of the original Church, whose overgrown remains can be found on the right hand side of the avenue of Howth Castle, just before you reach the turn for the Transport Museum and the Cookery School. To mark this historic anniversary St. Mary's are holding a special Celebratory Service on Sunday, October 16th at 7p.m. at which the preacher will be the Archbishop of Armagh and Primate of All Ireland, the Most Reverend Dr. Richard Clarke. *This Service is open to all and we hope that many of our friends and neighbours from Howth, Sutton and beyond will join us as we celebrate this historic occasion.*

SUTTON PARK & LAWNS RESIDENTS ASSOCIATION

RE: Brickfield, Amenity Zoned Open Space, Seagrange Park, Dublin 13.

It has come to our attention that an attempt will be made to rezone the Amenity Zoned Open Space at Brickfield to Residential in early October, 2016 by Fingal County Councillors. The motions, under specific objections from our Community Ref.D00394/2018, will be proposed by Cllr Keith Redmond on behalf of a Co. Wicklow developer, under cover of the Fingal Draft County Development Plan 2017 –2023 without public consultation. The location is on designated Flood Plain and includes an unauthorised dump No.8155 which has not been sanctioned or remediated. We would ask you to contact your local Councillors on the issue and request withdrawal of the motions. We look forward to your support.
