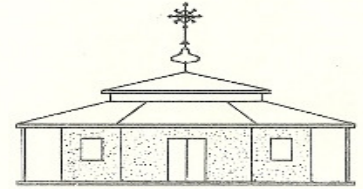

AFTER THE SABBETH, AND TOWARDS DAWN ON THE FIRST DAY OF THE WEEK, MARY OF MAGDALA AND THE OTHER MARY WENT TO VISIT THE SEPULCHRE. AND ALL AT ONCE THERE WAS A VIOLENT EARTHQUAKE, FOR THE ANGEL OF THE LORD, DESCENDING FROM HEAVEN CAME AND ROLLED AWAY THE STONE AND SAT ON IT. HIS FACE WAS LIKE LIGHTNING, HIS ROBE WHITE AS SNOW. THE GUARDS WERE SO SHAKEN SO FRIGHTENED OF HIM, THAT THEY WERE LIKE DEAD MEN. BUT THE ANGEL SPOKE; AND HE SAID TO THE WOMEN, "THERE IS NO NEED FOR YOU TO BE AFRAID. I KNOW YOU ARE LOOKING FOR JESUS, WHO WAS CRUCIFIED. HE IS NOT HERE, FOR HE HAS RISEN AS HE SAID HE WOULD. COME AND SEE THE PLACE WHERE HE LAY, THEN GO QUICKLY AND TELL HIS DISCIPLES, 'HE HAS RISEN FROM THE DEAD AND NOW HE IS GOING BEFORE YOU TO GALILEE; IT IS THERE YOU WILL SEE HIM'".

.....SO PETER SET OUT WITH THE OTHER DISCIPLES TO GO TO THE TOMB. THEY RAN TOGETHER, BUT THE OTHER DISCIPLE, RUNNING FASTER THAN PETER, REACHED THE TOMB FIRST; HE BENT DOWN AND SAW THE LINEN CLOTHS LYING ON THE GROUND, BUT DID NOT GO IN. SIMON PETER WHO WAS FOLLOWING NOW CAME UP, WENT RIGHT INTO THE TOMB, SAW THE LINEN CLOTHS ON THE GROUND, AND ALSO THE CLOTH THAT HAD BEEN OVER HIS HEAD; THIS WAS NOT WITH THE LINEN CLOTHS ON THE GROUND, BUT ROLLED UP IN A PLACE BY ITSELF. THEN THE OTHER DISCIPLE WHO HAD REACHED THE TOMB FIRST ALSO WENT IN; HE SAW AND HE BELIEVED. TILL THIS MOMENT THEY HAD FAILED TO UNDERSTAND THE TEACHING OF SCRIPTURE, THAT HE MUST RISE FROM THE DEAD.
