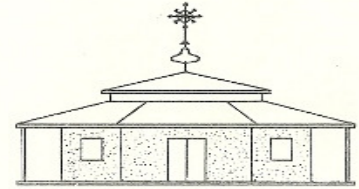

**THE WHOLE COMMUNITY REMAINED FAITHFUL TO THE TEACHING OF THE APOSTLES, TO THE COMMUNITY, TO THE BREAKING OF BREAD AND TO THE PRAYERS. Acts 2:42-47**

IN THE EVENING OF THAT SAME DAY, THE FIRST DAY OF THE WEEK, THE DOORS WERE CLOSED IN THE ROOM WHERE THE DISCIPLES WERE, FOR FEAR OF THE JEWS. JESUS CAME AND STOOD AMONG THEM. HE SAID TO THEM, 'PEACE BE WITH YOU' AND SHOWED THEM HIS HANDS AND HIS SIDE. THE DISCIPLES WERE FILLED WITH JOY WHEN THEY SAW THE LORD, AND HE SAID TO THEM AGAIN, 'PEACE BE WITH YOU. 'AS THE FATHER SENT ME, SO AM I SENDING YOU'. AFTER THIS HE BREATHED ON THEM AND SAID: 'RECEIVE THE HOLY SPIRIT. FOR THOSE WHOSE SINS YOU FORGIVE, THEY ARE FORGIVEN; FOR THOSE WHOSE SINS YOU RETAIN, THEY ARE RETAINED.' THOMAS, CALLED THE TWIN, WHO WAS ONE OF THE TWELVE, WAS NOT WITH THEM WHEN JESUS CAME. WHEN THE DISCIPLES SAID, "WE HAVE SEEN THE LORD", HE ANSWERED, 'UNLESS I SEE THE HOLES THAT THE NAILS MADE IN HIS HANDS AND CAN PUT MY FINGER INTO THE HOLES THEY MADE, AND UNLESS I CAN PUT MY HAND INTO HIS SIDE, I REFUSE TO BELIEVE'. EIGHT DAYS LATER THE DISCIPLES WERE IN THE HOUSE AGAIN AND THOMAS WAS WITH THEM. THE DOORS WERE CLOSED, BUT JESUS CAME IN AND STOOD AMONG THEM. 'PEACE BE WITH YOU' HE SAID. THEN HE SPOKE TO THOMAS, 'PUT YOUR FINGER HERE; LOOK, HERE ARE MY HANDS. GIVE ME YOUR HAND; PUT IT INTO MY SIDE. DOUBT NO LONGER BUT BELIEVE.' THOMAS REPLIED, 'MY LORD AND MY GOD!'

 BAYSIDE PARISH**

As you are aware the safeguarding of children and their involvement in our Parish is of the utmost importance to us all. As part of this, the Dublin Diocesan Child Safeguarding Office is doing an audit of each Parish at the moment.  
 All Parish personnel (including Priests, Sisters, Staff, Sacristans, Children's liturgy & Choir Leaders, Minister of the Word & Eucharist, Music Director and adult Choir Members, Bethany Bereavement Support etc. ) need current Garda Vetting & short input on Safeguarding Children. The Diocesan trainer, Mr. Garry Kehoe has agreed to give one of these sessions on 24th May at 10.30 a.m. after Mass in the Parish Centre, Kilbarrack/Foxfield (duration approx. one and 1/2 hours.) We would like to invite all of you involved in Bayside Parish to attend.  
 We would also like to ask all of you to ensure that your Garda Vetting status with the Parish is up to date. Forms are available from Sr. Eileen or in the Parish Office. Please note that Garda vetting information is strictly confidential.
