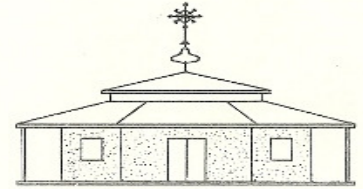

BAYSIDE MISSIONARY PROJECT

Please support our **CHURCH GATE COLLECTION** for famine affected South Sudan this Sunday, April 30th. In 2005 members of the project visited Ethiopia and were shown the work supported by Bayside for 20 years up to that time. Fr. John Skinnader and Fr. Paddy Moran were our hosts on that occasion. We still support our twin areas in Arbaminch/Dimeka but Fr. John is now working in South Sudan. He has sent an urgent appeal for help. Sudan has been in chaos since it gained Independence in July 2011. A civil war followed hot on the heels of nationhood and any chance of development or creating an Independent country has proved impossible. He is working on the ground and all funds collected go to him and his area which is greatly affected by hunger.

We appreciate any donation you can make but have one more request to make— like many countries in the developing world the supply of guns never seems to dry up. Sudan is a dangerous place for peaceful people. Your prayers for peace are much needed.
