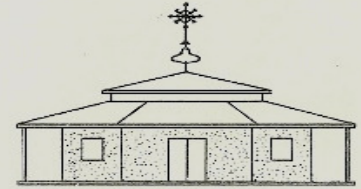

### AGONY OF JESUS IN THE GARDEN

AMONG THOSE WHO WENT UP TO WORSHIP AT THE FESTIVAL WERE SOME GREEKS. THESE APPROACHED PHILIP, WHO CAME FROM BETHSAIDA IN GALILEE, AND PUT THIS REQUEST TO HIM, 'SIR WE SHOULD LIKE TO SEE JESUS.' PHILIP WENT TO ANDREW, AND ANDREW AND PHILIP WENT TO TELL JESUS. JESUS REPLIED TO THEM: NOW THE HOUR HAS COME FOR THE SON OF MAN TO BE GLORIFIED. I TELL YOU MOST SOLEMNLY, UNLESS A WHEAT GRAIN FALLS ON THE GROUND AND DIES, IT REMAINS ONLY A SINGLE GRAIN; BUT IF IT DIES, IT YIELDS A RICH HARVEST.....
