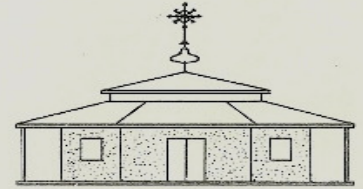

ST. JOSEPH'S YOUNG PRIESTS SOCIETY

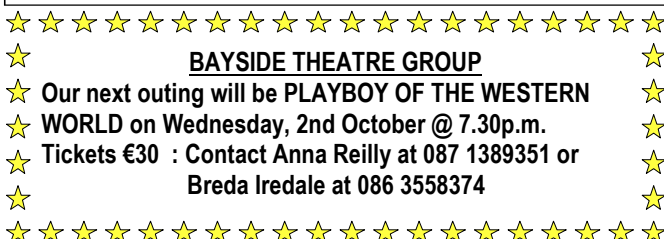
