## Reflection on Today's Gospel

Today we celebrate the feast of Christ the King. In the "Our Father" we pray "Thy kingdom come". However, when Jesus talks about the Kingdom of God, he means something very different from kings and kingdoms so often associated with excessive wealth etc. Jesus is a different type of king. His criteria are different from those of earthly kings: "I was hungry and you gave me food, I was thirsty and you gave me drink, a stranger and you welcomed me. . . The poor are the sacrament of Christ the King's presence in the world. This week, let's follow Jesus' way and respond with joyful and generous hearts.
