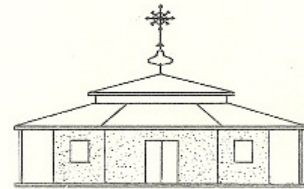

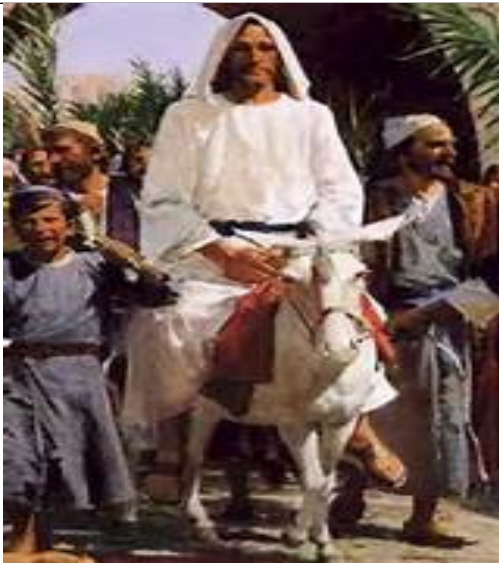

BAYSIDE MEALS ON WHEELS SERVICE
VOLUNTARY HELPERS NEEDED

This service has been in operation for the past 25 years. We deliver hot meals on Mondays, Wednesdays and Fridays, each week, to elderly people in the Bayside Parish. We supply home cooked dinners prepared by volunteers in the Community Centre and they are then delivered by volunteer drivers. The volunteers give a few hours of their time once a week, but only every second month. That works out at 4/5 days in 2 months.

We are not seeking Cordon Bleu Chefs— just new volunteers to peel the potatoes and help in the kitchen, and others to do the driving from door to door.

If you can spare a few hours every second month, we would be most grateful for your support to keep this service running.
