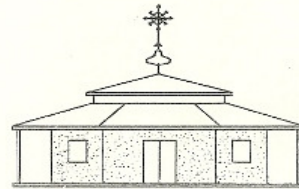

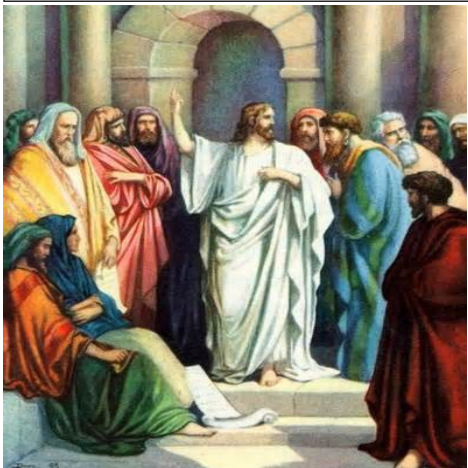

JESUS AND HIS FOLLOWERS WENT AS FAR AS CAPERNAUM, AND AS SOON AS THE SABBATH CAME JESUS WENT TO THE SYNAGOGUE AND BEGAN TO TEACH. AND HIS TEACHING MADE A DEEP IMPRESSION ON THEM BECAUSE, UNLIKE THE SCRIBES, HE TAUGHT THEM WITH AUTHORITY. AND HIS REPUTATION RAPIDLY SPREAD EVERYWHERE, THROUGH ALL THE SURROUNDING GALILEAN COUNTRYSIDE.
