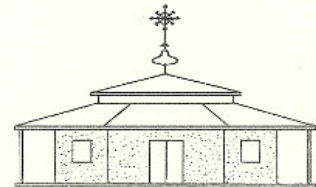

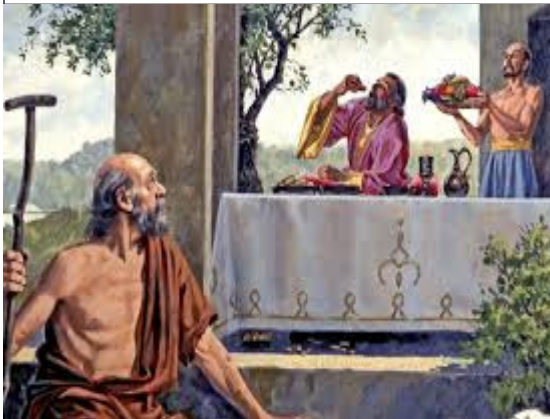

In this Parish, as in all Parishes, a number of measures are in place to keep children safe and to enhance their growth and development spiritually, emotionally, physically and intellectually: we obtain parents’ consent for children’s involvement in Parish activities : parish volunteers, priests and all involved are Garda vetted, etc. : there is a code of conduct to enhance children’s participation. The Parish representatives can be contacted through the Parish Office and contact details for those in Child Safeguarding and Protection services are displayed in the Porches of our Church.
