#### ARCHBISHOP OF DUBLIN LAUNCHES DIOCESAN FOOD APPEAL FOR CROSSCARE FOOD BANKS

Archbishop Diarmuid Martin is asking parishioners throughout the Archdiocese of Dublin to donate food to help stock Crosscare Food Banks in the weeks leading up to Christmas. This is the 4th Annual Diocesan Christmas Food Appeal. Demand on the Food Banks continues to increase and the situation is once again urgent.

Crosscare is the social care agency for the Archdiocese of Dublin. It operates 7 Food Banks around Dublin.
