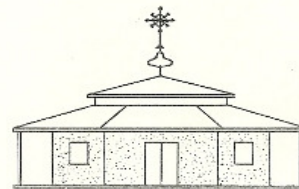

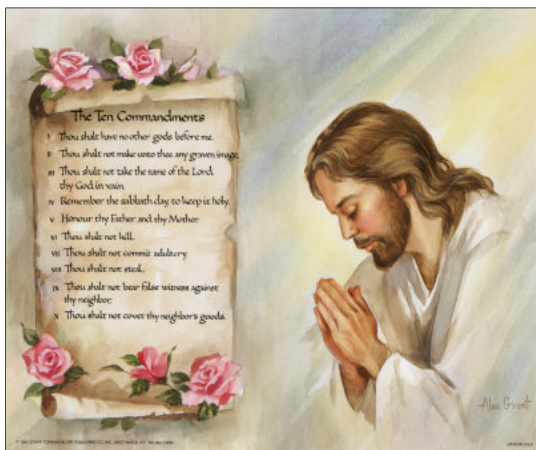

DO THIS IN MEMORY

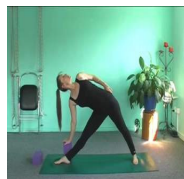
Next Sunday, 19th February, the "DO THIS IN MEMORY" Programme for children making their First Holy Communion will take place at the 10a.m. Mass.
