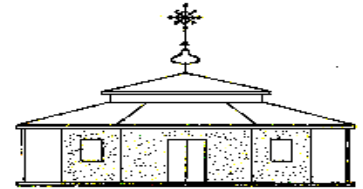

As we start our summer break, we would like to thank our supporters, our bakers, our setter-uppers, our put-away-ers, our raffle prize givers and our monthly helpers for yet another successful year thanks to their efforts and generosity.
