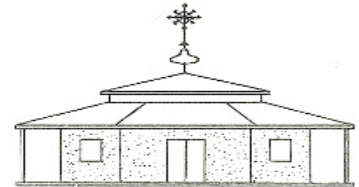

### SAFEGUARDING SUNDAY 24TH SEPTEMBER 2017

Pope Francis said: "*Families need to know that the Church is making every effort to protect their children. They should also know that they have every right to turn to the Church with full confidence for it is a safe and secure home*".

Ms Pat Hughes and Sr Eileen Browne are currently the Parish safeguarding representatives whose ministry is to ensure that diocesan safeguarding policies and practices are in place in this Parish. Safeguarding is all the things we do to ensure that children and vulnerable adults are protected from harm. They have both been trained for this role and have access to advice and support from the Diocesan Child Safeguarding and Protection Service. New developments in line with services by HSE to vulnerable adults, means attending to the safety of these special people. An interim diocesan policy on safeguarding vulnerable adults is being developed. Pat and Sr. Eileen will be attending various groups in the Parish at their ordinary meeting times, e.g. Ministers of the Word/ Eucharist/Choir, etc., to advise or help with the vetting process. They can be contacted through the Parish Office if anyone wishes to find out more or would like advice and information about a safeguarding matter.

Anyone who has a concern for the safety or welfare of a child or vulnerable adult should contact the Diocesan Child Safeguarding and Protection Service. People can also take such concerns directly to the civil Authorities— Tusla, the Child & Family Agency, if the concern relates to a child : HSE, if the concern relates to a vulnerable adult, or the Gardai, in an emergency. Contact details are on the Notice in the Church Porch.
