



SHE WRAPPED HIM IN SWADDLING CLOTHES, AND LAID HIM IN A MANGER BECAUSE THERE WAS NO ROOM FOR THEM AT THE INN. IN THE COUNTRYSIDE CLOSE BY THERE WERE SHEPHERDS WHO LIVED IN THE FIELDS AND TOOK IN TURNS TO WATCH THEIR FLOCKS DURING THE NIGHT.
