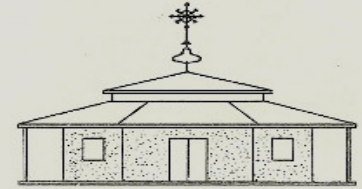

THE CHURCHES THROUGHOUT JUDAEA, GALILEE AND SAMARIA WERE NOW LEFT IN PEACE, BUILDING THEMSELVES UP, LIVING IN THE FEAR OF THE LORD AND FILLED WITH THE CONSOLATION OF THE HOLY SPIRIT.

EVERY BRANCH IN ME THAT BEARS NO FRUIT HE CUTS AWAY, AND EVERY BRANCH THAT DOES BEAR FRUIT HE PRUNES TO MAKE IT BEAR EVEN MORE. YOU ARE PRUNED ALREADY, BY MEANS OF THE WORD THAT I HAVE SPOKEN TO YOU. MAKE YOUR HOME IN ME, AS I MAKE MINE IN YOU. AS A BRANCH CANNOT BEAR FRUIT ALL BY ITSELF, BUT MUST REMAIN PART OF THE VINE, NEITHER CAN YOU UNLESS YOU REMAIN IN ME. I AM THE VINE, YOU ARE THE BRANCHES. WHOEVER REMAINS IN ME, WITH ME IN HIM, BEARS FRUIT IN PLENTY; FOR CUT OFF FROM ME YOU CAN DO NOTHING. ANYONE WHO DOES NOT REMAIN IN ME IS LIKE A BRANCH THAT HAS BEEN THROWN AWAY - HE WITHERS; THESE BRANCHES ARE COLLECTED AND THROWN ON THE FIRE, AND THEY ARE BURNT. IF YOU REMAIN IN ME AND MY WORDS REMAIN IN YOU, YOU MAY ASK WHAT YOU WILL AND YOU SHALL GET IT. IT IS TO THE GLORY OF MY FATHER THAT YOU SHOULD BEAR FRUIT, AND THEN YOU WILL BE MY DISCIPLES.' John

There is still time to register for the various events for the week in August from 21st August, ending with Pope Francis attending the Festival of Families on Saturday 25th August and the final Mass on Sunday 26th August.

Ecumenical Bible Week Ecumenical Bible Week will take place from 20th-27th May 2018. Now in its fifth year, it is a parish-based event that is jointly sponsored by the Archdiocese of Dublin, the combined dioceses of Dublin & Glendalough, and other key groups such as Scripture Union. The theme this year is *'Handing on Faith - Crisis, Challenge and the Great Commission'*. It begins on Pentecost Sunday with the launch event, *'Praying the New Cosmology'*, and will take place in 13 venues across Dublin and surrounding areas. Two key events take place in Holy Cross College, Clonliffe, Dublin on Thursday 24th May.
