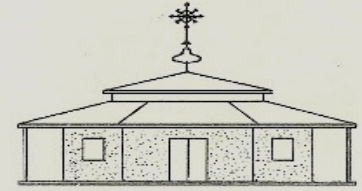

**DARKNESS INTO LIGHT WALK FOR PIETA HOUSE**  
**SATURDAY, 12TH MAY**  
 We are delighted to announce that we are organising a local walk in support of the annual "Darkness into Light" event organised by and in support of Pieta House. The event started in 2009 and this year 2018 there are roughly 180 venues across Ireland and worldwide. Last year 180,000 people 'shared the light' Pieta House offers free counselling to those suffering from suicidal thoughts, those who have been bereaved by suicide and people who are engaged in self-harm. This is a great chance for Bayside Community to raise awareness for the great work of Pieta House and to raise funds for them.  
 A 5k walk will start from Bayside Square to the end of the seafront/ causeway and will finish back at the Remembrance Garden in Bayside Park (Lamb Chop) where tea/coffee and sausages will be served. Walkers please assemble in the carpark at the Church next Saturday at 4a.m. for a 4.15a.m. SHARP start. Neighbours and extended Community can join in by sponsoring 'walkers' - donations can also be made online.
