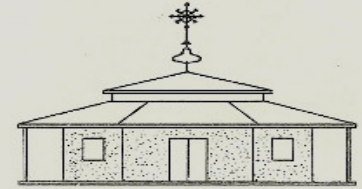

BAYSIDE MISSIONARY PROJECT

Many thanks to all who contributed to our Church Gate collection on 26th/27th May which raised €3,680 and included an anonymous donation of €1,000 for the Wonji Clinic, Ethiopia. We have now sent this year's €2000 to Wonji Clinic so all the 2017/2018 projects are completed. On June 1st our Coffee Morning raised €2627.53. With what remained in our account and the above funds the final 'winding up cushion' for each project ended up as €1490 each and as you read 4 bank drafts are winging their way to Africa.
We plan to sell our remaining stock of Christmas Cards in Nov/Dec and the money they bring in will go to Arbaminch and Dimeka - our first place of work and our Twin for a time.
Thanks again to all our supporters. Thanks to those who contributed funds, prizes, baking and time. Thanks too to the Priests and Sisters of the Parish, Sacristans, the Newsletter and the Community Centre Committee and staff. A final thank you to the businesses of Bayside who helped out with prizes on many occasions. Please keep our friends in Ethiopia, Zambia, Kenya and Sudan in your thoughts and prayers as they keep Bayside Parish in theirs.
