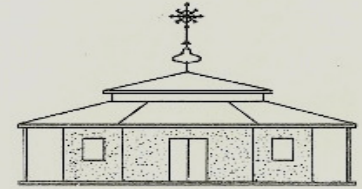

THE SMILE THAT LIT A 'MILLION HEARTS'
"IT LASTED BUT THIRTY-SIX HOURS"THE TINY WINDOW WITHIN WHICH MANY OF US FOLLOWED THE WHIRLWIND VISIT OF POPE FRANCIS LAST WEEKEND. IT WAS AN EXTRAORDINARY FEAT FOR A MAN IN HIS 80's AND YET IT SEEMS HE TOUCHED HUNDREDS OF THOUSANDS OF PEOPLES' LIVES IN UNEXPECTED WAYS. OUR SOCIETY HAS CHANGED SO DRASTICALLY SINCE POPE JOHN 11's VISIT. WE WONDERED WOULD THERE EVEN BE A WELCOME FOR POPE FRANCIS IN OUR DIVIDED SOCIETY. YET DESPITE THE INCREASED SECULARISM, THE RESISTANCE TO FORMAL RELIGION AND THE THROW-AWAY MATERIALISTIC CULTURE, THOUSANDS OF VOLUNTEERS STEPPED UP TO ENSURE THIS VISIT WOULDN'T BE FOUND LACKING WARMTH OR ENTHUSIASM. *AND ISNT IT THIS VERY GIFT OF SELF IN VOLUNTEERING THAT SETS THE TONE OF LOVE, OF JOY AND OF HOPE.* WE WITNESSED GREAT DIGNITY FROM OUR PRESIDENT, TAOISEACH AND GOVERNMENT. PEOPLE STRUGGLING ON THE MARGINS WERE GIVEN BLESSINGS AND A LISTENING EAR, SURVIVORS WHO SUFFERED BECAUSE OF ABUSIVE CLERICS WERE RIGHTLY GIVEN CENTRE STAGE.....THAT PLACE IN OUR SOCIETY WITH THE DEEPEST WOUNDS. AND POPE FRANCIS LISTENED.....RESPONDEDAND PROMISED. CROKE PARK WAS A STUNNING EXPERIENCE OF MUSIC, SONG, DRAMA AND DANCE AND THE ENTRANCE OF THE HOLY FATHER WAS GREETED BY CHEERS, FLAGS, BANNERS, SMILES, LAUGHTER & CLAPPING. THERE WAS A UNITY ABOUT IT ALL. KNOCK RECEIVED POPE FRANCIS WITH THE SAME DELIGHT. THOUSANDS PAYING RESPECT TO THE LEADER OF OUR FAITH ON EARTH. HIS DEVOTION TO MARY, THE MOTHER OF JESUS WAS MARKED WITH SILENT PRAYER AND INTERCESSIONS. FINALLY, THE MASS IN THE PHOENIX PARK EMERGED IN THE MIST WITH HUNDREDS OF THOUSANDS OF PILGRIMS BRAVING THE RAIN AND WIND AND LONG WALKS—MANY HAD TRAVELLED THROUGH THE NIGHT. UNBELIEVABLE NUMBERS OF YOUNG FAMILIES, BABIES, TODDLERS AND TEENS ARRIVED CHEERFULLY. SO MANY YOUNG PEOPLE WORKED AS VOLUNTEERS ENSURING WE WERE ALL CARED FOR. MONTHS OF PREPARATION BLENDED TOGETHER ALL THE STRANDS OF A BEAUTIFUL ALTAR/SANCTUARY DESIGN; LITTLE SUB-CHAPELS FOR HOLY COMMUNION; CLEAR ELECTRONIC SCREENS; GREAT SOUND SYSTEM, FOOD AND DRINK CORNERS, ETC. IT WAS AN ASTONISHING FEAT. I FOUND MYSELF IN A CORRAL WITH THREE GENERATIONS OF A CANADIAN FAMILY AND SIX PHILLIPINE YOUNG MEN & WOMEN WHO CAME SPECIALLY FOR THE EVENT. THE INTERNATIONAL NATURE OF THE GATHERING REMINDED US OF OUR GLOBAL VILLAGE WHERE THE CALL TO ONENESS IS EVER MORE URGENT AND CARE FOR OUR COMMON HOME, THE EARTH, IS CRUCIAL TO SURVIVAL. FOR EACH ONE OF US NOW THE QUESTION IS: HOW CAN THIS EXPERIENCE BE TRANSLATED INTO A WAY OF LIVING AND LOVING WHERE JESUS IS AT THE CENTRE ENCOURAGING US TOWARDS ACTIONS OF LOVING KINDNESS AND JUSTICE FOR ALL PEOPLE
