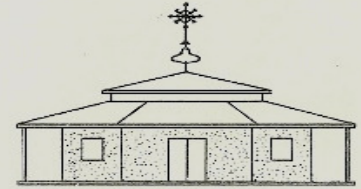

FOR ANYONE WHO IS IN CHRIST, THERE IS A NEW CREATION; THE OLD CREATION HAS GONE, AND NOW THE NEW ONE IS HERE. IT IS ALL GOD'S WORK.
