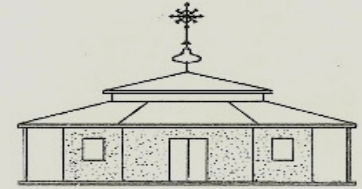

WHEN THEY SAW THE LORD*

..... THOMAS, CALLED THE TWIN, WHO WAS ONE OF THE TWELVE, WAS NOT WITH THEM WHEN JESUS CAME.
