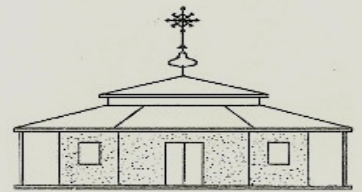

*FALLING TO THEIR KNEES THEY
DID HIM HOMAGE*

AFTER JESUS HAD BEEN BORN AT BETHLEHEM IN JUDAEA DURING THE REIGN OF KING HEROD, SOME WISE MEN CAME TO JERUSALEM FROM THE EAST. 'WHERE IS THE INFANT KING OF THE JEWS?' THEY ASKED. 'WE SAW HIS STAR AS IT ROSE AND HAVE COME TO DO HIM HOMAGE.' WHEN KING HEROD HEARD THIS HE WAS PERTURBED, AND SO WAS THE WHOLE OF JERUSALEM.
