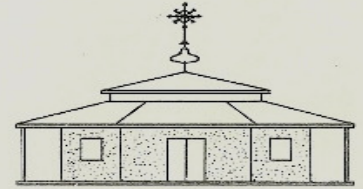

Re: Sutton Park Amenity Zoned Open Space Public Park Lands Folio 57308F

Fingal Co. Council, Property Services Division, in a letter dated 30/10/2019 Red LD 1319 to all Councillors, states that it proposes to sell off public park lands to CIE in response to an application from the Company. The lands are located on the east side of the Public Basketball Courts and Public Park grassed area. No public consultation whatever has taken place and no information is available as to its objective. An internal Council meeting is taking place on 6th November and a further Council meeting on 11th November, 2019. The lands are designated in Fingal Development Plan 2017-2023 "OS-open space to preserve and provide for open space and recreational amenities". The proposal is of major Community concern. We recommend you contact your local Public Representatives in the interest of saving the Open Space Public Park Lands. Thank you.
