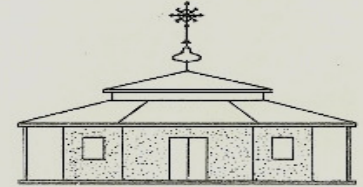

**TAX REFUND SCHEME:** We would like to thank everyone who responded to the recent appeal for 2016 tax claim. Approximately 20 parishioners responded along with many others who have already signed up for this scheme. The return for 2016 has now been sent to Revenue.

We are currently processing the 2017 returns and will be writing to a few parishioners who now qualify for the scheme. If you do not receive a letter and form but contribute over €250 in any given tax year it is probably due to the fact that you have already signed either the CHY3 form for 5 years or the CHY4 form for 1 year. Our new accounts system along with Revenue will notify us when your form is due for renewal and will write to you when that occurs. Once again our sincere thanks to all who have signed up for the scheme which enables our Church to meet many incoming expenses including heat, light, insurance, wages, other utilities and necessary purchases. This return helps maintain the smooth running of the Church and to meet our annual outlays.
