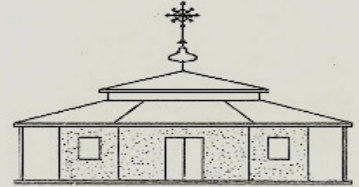

WEEK OF PRAYER FOR CHRISTIAN UNITY

The week of Prayer for Christian Unity takes place from 18th January to 25th January. The theme "they showed us unusual kindness was being prepared by Christians from Malta and Gozo which finds its origins in the Acts of the Apostles (Acts 27:18—28:10) and emphasis that it is through this unusual kindness that Christians are as one.
