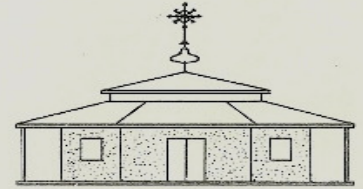

JESUS ENTERED JERICO AND WAS GOING THROUGH THE TOWN WHEN A MAN WHOSE NAME WAS ZACCHAEUS MADE HIS APPEARANCE; HE WAS ONE OF THE SENIOR TAX COLLECTORS AND A WEALTHY MAN. HE WAS ANXIOUS TO SEE WHAT KIND OF MAN JESUS WAS, BUT HE WAS TOO SHORT AND COULD NOT SEE HIM FOR THE CROWD; SO HE RAN AHEAD AND CLIMBED A SYCAMORE TREE TO CATCH A GLIMPSE OF JESUS WHO WAS TO PASS THAT WAY. WHEN JESUS REACHED THE SPOT HE LOOKED UP AND SPOKE TO HIM: 'ZACCHAEUS, COME DOWN. HURRY BECAUSE I MUST STAY AT YOUR HOUSE TODAY.' AND HE HURRIED DOWN AND WELCOMED HIM JOYFULLY. THEY ALL COMPLAINED WHEN THEY SAW WHAT WAS HAPPENING. 'HE HAS GONE TO STAY AT A SINNER'S HOUSE' THEY SAID.
