Reflection on Today's Gospel

'Listen to his voice!'

The theme of listening runs through today's readings: listening to the Divine Voice; the voice of the prophet Ezekiel; to our community members; to the Church.

In the Gospel, Jesus advises us of our duty to do what we can when an individual's behaviour is a threat to the community. Our community does not live separately from God: the Lord is active and present in the decisions and desires of his people and our prayer and action should reflect this.

Amidst the distractions and bustle of daily life, we pray to be alert for the Divine quiet voice. and to respond to it. We beg for the awareness of our responsibilities as a church community, especially to those most at risk across the world at this time.
