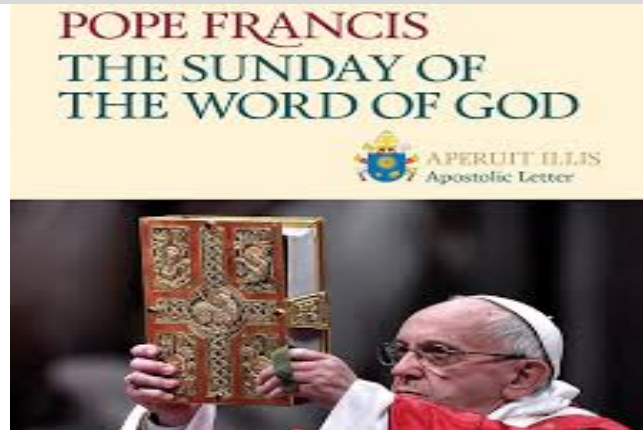
We encourage all those at home to pray as set out below –

**Arrangements for Celebration of the
Sacraments of
First Reconciliation, First Holy Communion and
Confirmation
Bayside Parish**

Bayside Junior and Senior School

1. This week the schools will contact the families of children preparing for the sacraments asking you to confirm your wish to register your child for First Reconciliation/First Holy Communion or Confirmation. The schools will also seek permission to pass on your email address to Bayside Parish. You will be required to respond via Aladdin Connect. Please respond by Monday 15th March.
2. The Parish will engage in preparation with families so that they will be ready for celebration of the sacraments whenever we may safely gather to do so.
3. Teachers will continue to teach the Grow in Love programme.
4. The Parish will contact the parents/guardians of candidates seeking parent volunteers to assist with the celebration of each sacrament. The focus of the parent group will be on supporting children so that they are prepared to celebrate the sacraments whenever, and in whatever format, this proves possible.
5. As soon as liturgical celebrations can be safely resumed we will prioritise the celebration of sacraments for children where this could not happen last year, then children who are due to celebrate Confirmation this year, followed by First Reconciliation and First Holy Communion.

5. If the transaction was successful you should hear a beep and a thank-you will appear on the screen. One tap covers both first and second collection. We cannot attend Mass in person now but if you wish to donate, you may 'tap' any time you come to the church.
